Resolution authorizing the Department of Technology to approve the Second
Amendment with AT&T dba AT&T Mobility to purchase public safety-grade wireless
communications services for first responders, extending the term by eighteen months
from October 21, 2025, for a total term of June 23, 2020, through April 21, 2027, and
increasing the agreement amount by \$7,319,751 for a total contract amount of
\$29,572,719 pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118.
WHEREAS, On June 23, 2020, the Department of Technology ("Department") entered
into an agreement for the City and County of San Francisco ("City") to purchase public safety-
grade wireless communications services for first responders ("First Net Services") from AT&T
dba AT&T Mobility ("AT&T Mobility") in reliance upon the competitive procurement process of
the FirstNet Authority and using the directly negotiated California Network and
Telecommunications ("CALNET") FirstNet Contract C3A2FN9-18 of the California Department
of Technology ("CDT") for FirstNet Services awarded to AT&T Mobility ("AT&T Mobility FirstNet
Agreement"), pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 21.16(b); and
WHEREAS, The First Amendment to the agreement was approved by the Board of
Supervisors on March 14, 2023, to increase the not to exceed amount to \$22,252,968 because
City departments authorized more City first responders to use FirstNet Services than the
Department anticipated when it entered into this agreement; and
WHEREAS, The CDT has extended the CALNET contract this agreement utilizes by
eighteen months to provide the CDT with more time to negotiate a successor contract, which
necessitates this second amendment to keep our agreement aligned with CALNET; and

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1	WHEREAS, The proposed \$7,319,751 increase in this agreement was determined
2	based on projected costs and the continuing growth in demand for FirstNet services, including
3	wider deployment of FirstNet to public safety staff, necessary device replacement, inflationary
4	price increases, and strategic migration from other carriers to consolidate spending on FirstNet;
5	and
6	WHEREAS, The Department has made substantial efforts to contain costs and drive
7	efficiency in the City's mobile portfolio, such as implementing a citywide Mobile Device Use
8	Policy, developing a tool to identify and deactivate unused mobile lines, and removing 1,161
9	unused or unnecessary lines over the past two years; and
10	WHEREAS, Section 9.118 of the San Francisco Charter requires approval by the Board
11	of Supervisors for contracts requiring expenditures above \$10,000,000; now, therefore, be it
12	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the Second Amendment to the
13	AT&T FirstNet Agreement between the City and AT&T Mobility to allow City departments to
14	continue to purchase FirstNet services from AT&T Mobility extending the term by eighteen
15	months, from October 21, 2025, for a total term of June 23, 2020, through April 21, 2027 and a
16	not to exceed amount of \$29,572,719; and, be it
17	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Second Amendment being fully
18	executed by the parties the Department of Technology shall provide a copy of it to the Clerk of
