3 **Resolution urging the California Department of Education’s Child Development**
4 **Division to reconsider its decision to divide San Francisco’s child care and**
5 **development resource and referral service areas by zip code.**

7 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco’s has a long history and track
8 record in supporting the youth and families throughout the City providing funding to our two
9 child care resource and referral agencies, Wu Yee Children’s Services and the Children’s
10 Council of San Francisco, for enhanced services; and

11 WHEREAS, The Department of Children, Youth and Their Families is committed to the
12 mission of supporting programs and activities in every San Francisco neighborhood; and

13 WHEREAS, The California Department of Education’s Child Development Division is
14 requesting that San Francisco divides its service areas by zip codes; and

15 WHEREAS, The California Department of Education’s Child Development Division
16 states in its program requirements for the Child Care and Development Resource and
17 Referral Program to be “responsive to the diverse cultural, linguistic, and economic needs of
18 the service area;” and

19 WHEREAS, The current Resource and Referral contractors for San Francisco, Wu Yee
20 Children’s Services and the Children’s Council of San Francisco, serve children across the
21 City regardless of zip code; and

22 WHEREAS, Wu Yee Children’s Services and the Children’s Council of San Francisco
23 have worked for nearly forty years to ensure that families have access to seamless and
24 complementary family services; and

1 WHEREAS, The families in San Francisco live, work, and receive care in multiple
2 neighborhoods that overlap different zip codes; and

3 WHEREAS, The current framework allows families to choose programs in San
4 Francisco that best fit their needs; and

5 WHEREAS, The division of services restricted to zip codes would create hardship and
6 inefficiencies to support families; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors and the City and County of San Francisco
8 urges the California Department of Education to reconsider the division of resource and
9 referral service areas by zip code; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That in order to ensure quality services for all children and
11 families, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the
12 California Department of Education to maintain the current system for determining resource
13 and referral service areas.
