2 AMENDING ARTICLE XV, PART I OF THE SAN FRANCISCO MUNICIPAL CODE  
3 (ADMINISTRATIVE CODE), WHICH ESTABLISHED CASH REVOLVING ACCOUNTS FOR  
4 THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO DEPARTMENTS, BY AMENDING  
5 SECTION 10.157 TO INCREASE THE TOTAL AMOUNT IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN  
6 SERVICES CASH REVOLVING ACCOUNT; AND BY DELETING SECTIONS 10.157-1 AND  
7 10.157-2 TO CONSOLIDATE THE AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN  
8 (AFDC) AND GENERAL ASSISTANCE (GA) ACCOUNTS INTO ONE DEPARTMENT OF  
9 HUMAN SERVICES CASH REVOLVING ACCOUNT.

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

14 Section 1. Article XV of the San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended  
15 by amending Section 10.157, to read as follows:

16 SEC. 10.157. CASH REVOLVING ((FUNDS)) ACCOUNTS - DEPARTMENT OF  
17 HUMAN SERVICES; ((\$20,000)) \$450,000.

19 Section 2. Article XV of the San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended  
20 by repealing Section 10.157-1, as follows:

21 ((SEC. 10.157-1. CASH REVOLVING FUNDS - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN  
22 SERVICES - AFDC; \$50,000.

23 The Controller is hereby authorized to transfer amounts up to \$50,000 from the current  
24 appropriation for Aid to Families with Dependent Children ("AFDC") to create a separate  
25 revolving fund with a maximum balance of \$50,000 to provide funds for immediate need

1 checks for welfare cases, instead of food, rent, commodity and cash emergency orders, and  
2 for the replacement of mutilated checks.))

4 Section 3. Article XV of the San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended  
5 by repealing Section 10.157-2, as follows:


6 ((SEC. 10.157-2. CASH REVOLVING FUNDS - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN  
7 SERVICES - GENERAL ASSISTANCE; \$200,000.

8 The Controller is hereby authorized to transfer amounts up to \$200,000 from the  
9 current appropriation for General Assistance to a separate revolving fund to provide funds for  
10 immediate need checks for welfare cases, instead of food, rent, commodity and cash  
11 emergency orders, and for the replacement of mutilated checks.))

Ordinance amending Article XV, Part I of the San Francisco Municipal Code (Administrative Code), which established cash revolving accounts for the City and County of San Francisco Departments, by amending Section 10.157 to increase the total amount in the Department of Human Services Cash Revolving Account; and by deleting Sections 10.157-1 and 10.157.2 to consolidate the Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) and General Assistance (GA) accounts into one Department of Human Services Cash Revolving Account.
