

1 [Provide SSI application assistance to the chronically homeless and mentally ill in San
2 Francisco.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
4 **accept retroactively and expend a grant in the amount of \$195,320 from the Social**
5 **Security Administration (SSA) to provide SSI application assistance to the chronically**
6 **homeless and mentally ill in San Francisco and to enter into an agreement for the use**
7 **of these funds; for the period of May 1, 2004, to April 30, 2005.**

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9 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from SSA in the
10 amount of \$195,320 to provide SSI application assistance to the chronically homeless and
11 mentally ill in San Francisco; and,

12 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, SSA requires the City to enter
13 into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
14 Supervisors in File No. 041164, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if
15 set forth fully herein; and,

16 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors
17 because the notice of the award was not received from SSA until June 14, 2004; and,

18 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
19 may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
20 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
21 of grant funding; and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$1,263; now,
23 therefore, be it

24 **RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a**
25 **grant in the amount of \$195,320 from SSA; and, be it**

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
2 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement, pursuant to San
3 Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
5 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded
7 under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the
8 agreement expires.
