

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Reentry Council]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to require that Mayoral and Board of Supervisors appointments to the Reentry Council expire following a member's hiring at designated City departments; increase the number of Reentry Council officers from four to five and require that the fifth officer be a formerly incarcerated member; and increase from 12 to 13 the number of members that constitute a quorum.

Existing Law

Existing law establishes the Reentry Council to coordinate local efforts to support adults exiting San Francisco County Jail, San Francisco juvenile justice system out-of-home placements, the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation facilities, and the United States Federal Bureau of Prison facilities. Existing law authorizes the Mayor and Board of Supervisors to appoint persons to the Council, designates officers, and defines a quorum as 12 members.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance requires that Mayoral and Board appointments expire following a member's hiring at certain City departments, adds a fifth officer who must be a formerly incarcerated member and increases from 12 to 13 the number of members required for a quorum.
