2 URGING THE CREATION AND SITING OF A COMMEMORATIVE PLAQUE TO HONOR
3 THOSE OF GREEK ANCESTRY WHO HELPED MAKE SAN FRANCISCO AN INCREDIBLY
4 DIVERSE AND VIBRANT CITY.

5 WHEREAS, San Francisco is a City with a unique aggregation of
6 different communities of ancestry; and,

7 WHEREAS, Persons of Greek ancestry comprise one of the pioneer
8 communities that founded San Francisco; and,

9 WHEREAS, Persons of Greek ancestry, including such luminaries as
10 former Mayor George Christopher and former Supervisor Peter Tamaras,
11 have made extraordinary contributions to the history of San
12 Francisco; and,

13 WHEREAS, San Franciscans of Greek ancestry form the largest and
14 most viable Greek colony west of the Mississippi River; and,

15 WHEREAS, The creation and siting of a commemorative plaque in
16 the South of Market Area, that neighborhood which became the center
17 Greek settlement, would be an appropriate way to honor that
18 community's contributions; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Works take all
20 appropriate steps to ensure that a plaque commemorating San
21 Francisco's Greek community is created and sited in an appropriate
22 place within the South of Market district; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be sent to
24 Mr. George Daskarolis, 21 Knoll Ridge Way, Oakland, CA 94619.


