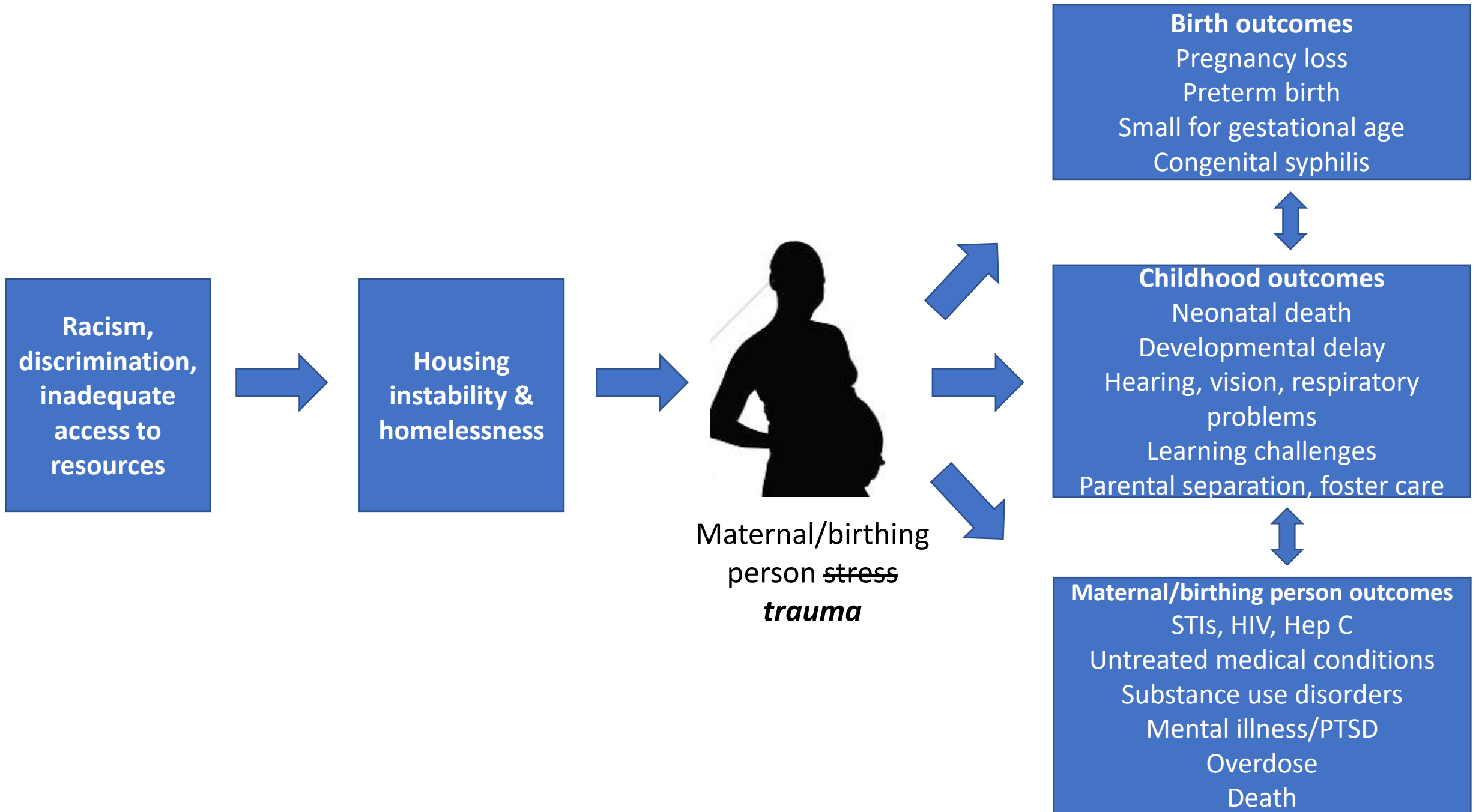


Increasing housing instability → increased preterm birth.



San Francisco has tremendous inequities in housing and birth outcomes.

- Black birthing people have ~9X likelihood of housing instability in pregnancy compared to general population in SF.
- Black birthing people have 2X likelihood of having a preterm birth compared to white women in SF.
