WHEREAS, The California Department of Motor Vehicles previously refused to accept domestic partnership certificates as valid documentation for identifying individuals and establishing a change of name; and,

WHEREAS, A domestic partner who previously wished to change his or her name at the Department of Motor Vehicles was required to go to court and pay \$200 to process the court papers for a name change, while married couples could present a marriage certificate and process a name change for \$15; and,

WHEREAS, The California Department of Motor Vehicles reviewed this disparity and decided to change its policy; and,

WHEREAS, The California Department of Motor Vehicles has drafted a policy memo to be distributed to all local agencies that directs local agencies to accept state and local domestic partnership papers as sufficient documentation for the establishment of truthful name; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commends the California Department of Motor Vehicles for changing its policy to accept domestic partnership certificates for identification and name change purposes.
