**MEMORANDUM**

 Subject: **Caltrain Feeder Service Agreement**

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) proposes to execute the Feeder Service Agreement (Agreement) between the City and County of San Francisco and the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board (JPB). SFMTA currently provides public transit service to and from the Caltrain station at Fourth at King Streets in San Francisco. The proposed Agreement would require annual payments from the JPB in order to offset operating costs of the existing transit service serving the Caltrain station. The Agreement would not modify existing public transit service, and any transit service changes affecting route(s) serving the Caltrain station would require subsequent approval by SFMTA.

Not a project under CEQA Guidelines Sections 15060(c) because the action would not result in a direct physical change in the environment, or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.
