

1 [Treasure Island Public Access]

2 RESOLUTION URGING THE TREASURE ISLAND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY  
3 TO STUDY AND DEVELOP A LIMITED PUBLIC ACCESS PLAN AND REPORT  
4 THE PLAN TO THE COMMITTEE ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,  
5 TRANSPORTATION AND TECHNOLOGY OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
6 WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE PASSAGE OF THIS RESOLUTION.

7 WHEREAS, Treasure Island has sweeping vistas of the San Francisco Bay and  
8 open areas for pic-nicking, fishing, and other outdoor activities; and

9 WHEREAS, Public access to these outdoor opportunities on Treasure Island is  
10 presently limited due to liability while the island is in transition; and

11 WHEREAS, Access to Treasure Island is also limited in the evening hours due to  
12 public safety risks; and

13 WHEREAS, In order to address liability and public safety concerns, a Treasure  
14 Island public access plan must include adequate monitoring, coordination and security;  
15 and

16 WHEREAS, The Navy currently possesses Treasure Island; and

17 WHEREAS, Treasure Island is a valuable resource that should be available for  
18 safe and limited public enjoyment; and

19 WHEREAS, A carefully studied and developed public access plan could provide  
20 opportunities for the public to safely enjoy the vistas and outdoor recreation on Treasure  
21 Island; now, therefore be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San  
23 Francisco urges the Treasure Island Development Authority to study and develop a public  
24 access plan for Treasure Island and report the plan to the Committee on Economic  
25 Development, Transportation and Technology of the Board of Supervisors within 30 days  
of the passage of this resolution.




