I have served as the Executive Director of Folsom Street Events for the past 8 and 1/2 years, working with many residents, business owners, bars/night clubs, event venues, and government agencies in order to produce seven annual events for the GLBT, leather and fetish communities. Our events attract an international base of tourists. On a personal level, I am a gay man who has been living with HIV for nearly 20 years. My background is executive and fundraising work in HIV/AIDS services, including youth work, mental health, and substance abuse. My connections to the nonprofit sector are especially strong, given that much of my current work focuses on donating net proceeds to select beneficiaries.



I inspired and advocated for Parking Lot Legislation in 2012 that finally enforces public safety responsibility on parking lot owners and not nearby clubs. I have also been active in advocating for safer party busses and prevention of cell phone thefts in nightclubs.

In the area of non-profit community service, I have created fundraisers for the Nihonmachi Street Fair, Chinese New Comer Services, Kimochi Senior Services, Asian Pacific America Public Affairs Internship Program and Typhoon Relief for the Philippines. My current community side project is the reopening of Chinatown's 100-year old restaurant, the Sam Wo. Another project is spearheading the national campaign to erect a vastly improved monument dedicated to the 1200 plus Chinese railroad workers who lost their lives in the Sierra Mountains building the Transcontinental Railroad.

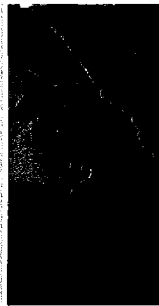

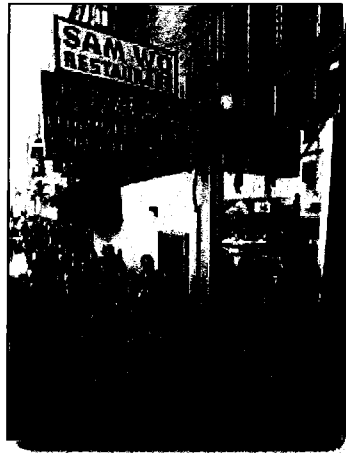

CHINESE RAILROAD WORKER MEMORIAL MONUMENT PROJECT

Between 1865 and 1869, 10–15 thousands of Chinese migrants toiled at a grueling pace and in perilous working conditions to help construct America's First Transcontinental Railroad. The Chinese Railroad Workers Memorial Monument Project seeks to give a recognized solemn tribute to the Chinese migrants who lost their lives laboring on the Transcontinental Railroad, which shape the physical and social landscape of the American West.

In 1865, Charles Crocker needed thousands of workers to begin work on the Central Pacific Railroad portion of the construction of the first transcontinental line in North America in order to meet a Congressional time mandate. He proceeded to recruit workers in South China who took part in the construction project that culminated in 1869 with Leland Stanford driving in the famous "golden spike" to complete the line. This Project's goal is to bring greater national recognition and tribute to the Chinese workers who played an absolutely central role in building the infrastructure that linked the East Coast to the West Coast of the U.S.



The Chinese Railroad Workers are one of a few pioneers that do not have any significant monument that pays tribute to their work and lives lost while working in the harsh Sierra's mountain ranges.

Located at a rest stop off Interstate 80, at Dutch Flats, near Gold Run, the Placer County Historical Society placed a marker where the Chinese workers first started working on the Transcontinental Railroad. With the full support of the PCHS, our new Monument will replace the large rock, that the



organization place in 2009, as seen in the photo on the above.

In 2015, commemorating the 150 anniversary of the Chinese Railroad Worker, two major events are planned. Stanford University will be organizing major conferences and public events on the campus and in China. <http://www.stanford.edu/group/chineserailroad/cgi-bin/wordpress/>

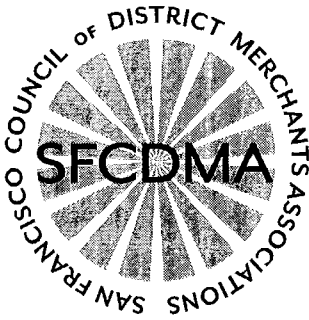



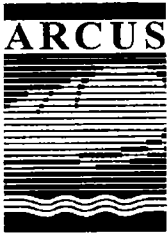

Charter, Section 4.117 (Prop F, November 2002 Election) and Administrative Code, Chapter 90 (Ordinance Nos. 164-02; 242-05; and 100-13)

Board Qualifications:

The Entertainment Commission shall consist of seven (7) members, comprised of three (3) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors and four (4) members nominated by the Mayor.

Each nomination by the Mayor shall be subject to approval by the Board of Supervisors and shall be the subject of a public hearing and vote within 60 days. If the Board of Supervisors fails to act on a mayoral nomination within 60 days from the date the nomination is transmitted to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, the nominee shall be deemed approved.

Of the four (4) members nominated by the Mayor:

- > One (1) member must represent the interests of City neighborhood associations or groups;
- > One (1) member must represent the interests of entertainment associations or groups;
- > One (1) member must represent the interests of the urban planning community; and
- > One (1) member must represent the interests of the law enforcement community.

Of the three (3) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors:

- > One (1) member must represent the interests of City neighborhood associations or groups;
- > One (1) member must represent the interests of entertainment associations or groups; and
- > One (1) member must represent the interests of the public health community.

To stagger the terms, the initial appointments to the commission shall be as follows: the Mayor

nominates two members to serve terms of four years, one member to serve a term of three years and one member to serve a term of two years. Of the three remaining members, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint one member to serve a term of four years, one member to serve a term of three years and one member to serve a term of two years. All terms of initial appointees to the commission shall be deemed to commence upon the same date which shall be the date upon which the last of the seven initial appointees assumes office. Thereafter, all appointments and reappointments shall be for a term of four years.

The Entertainment Commission shall: 1) assist entertainment organizers and operators to apply for necessary permits; 2) promote responsible conduct; 3) promote the City's entertainment industry; 4) promote the use of City facilities; 5) foster harm reduction policies; 6) develop "good neighbor policies"; 7) mediate disputes between persons affected by entertainment events and establishments and the operators of such establishments; 8) issue entertainment related permits; 9) plan and coordinate City services for major events; and 10) provide information regarding venues and services appropriate for events and functions ancillary to conventions.

Reports: Prepare and submit to the Mayor and Board of Supervisors: 1) within one year from July 6, 2002, and not less than five years thereafter, a report analyzing the Commission's effectiveness; 2) an annual report by March 1st regarding its activities for the preceding year; and 3) within one year from July 6, 2002, and annually thereafter, a report analyzing fee revenue.
