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3 **Ordinance making environmental findings and amending San Francisco Park Code,**
4 **Article 12, Section 12.11 to increase the West Harbor berth rental fees in fiscal year**
5 **2012-2013, or upon completion of the West Harbor renovations.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Findings.

11 The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this
12 Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public
13 Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the
14 Board of Supervisors in File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by reference.

15 Section 2. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section
16 12.11, to read as follows:

17 SEC. 12.11. MARINA FEES.

18 The following fees shall be charged for goods and services at the San Francisco
19 Marina Small Craft Harbor:

20 (a) Berth Rental Fees. The charges shall be based on the overall length of the entire
21 vessel or the length of the berth, which ever is greater.

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2 (j) Adjustment of Fees. The berth rental and guest dock fees for the West Harbor shall
3 be increased, without further action of the Board of Supervisors, for Fiscal Year 2006 – 2007
4 by twenty (20) percent, and for Fiscal Years 2007 – 2008, 2008--2009, 2009 – 2010, by four
5 (4) percent per year. Thereafter the berth rental and guest dock fees shall be adjusted in
6 accordance with Section 12.20 of this article.

7 The berth rental and guest dock fees for the East Harbor shall be increased, without
8 further action of the Board of Supervisors, for Fiscal Years 2006 – 2007, 2007 – 2008, 2008 –
9 2009 by twelve (12) percent. Thereafter the berth rental and guest dock fees shall be
10 adjusted in accordance with Section 12.20 of this article.
