SUBJECT: Proposed Amendments to File No. 220606

Dear Clerk Young,

As discussed at the Rules Committee meeting on July 18, 2022, Supervisor Peskin requests that the following proposed amendments to File No. 220606 be included in the file for public review.

- Clarifying that authorized requests for historical video footage shall be for “specific portions of” historical video footage that contain evidence relevant to a criminal investigation or internal investigation regarding officer misconduct, and striking the words “for purposes of gathering;”
- Limiting authorization for live monitoring during First Amendment activities “unless there is an exigent circumstance,” and deleting “for reasons outside of redeployment needs due to crowd sizes or other issues creating public safety hazards;” and
- Limiting the sharing of data with recipients to law enforcement agencies “who are California public agencies” and requiring that the Department comply with “San Francisco’s Sanctuary Ordinance (Administrative Code Section 12H & I et seq.)”
