3 **Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type-90 on-sale general music**
4 **venue liquor license to SR Visions, LLC, to do business as 7 Social, located at 65**
5 **Post Street (District 3), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City**
6 **and County of San Francisco, in accordance with California Business and**
7 **Professions Code, Section 23958.4; and requesting that the California Department**
8 **of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.**

10 WHEREAS, SR Visions, LLC is seeking the issuance of a Type-90 on-sale
11 general music venue liquor license to do business as 7 Social located at 65 Post Street
12 (District 3); and

13 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
14 zoned and recommends approval; and

15 WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero protests and zero letters of
16 support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business
17 and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of
18 Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

19 WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the
20 following: 1) Petitioner(s) shall actively monitor the area under their control in an effort
21 to prevent the loitering of persons on any property adjacent to the licensed premises as
22 depicted on the ABC-253; 2) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free
23 of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control, as depicted on
24 ABC-253; 3) (1) Except as provided in Condition 2 below, no noise shall be audible
25 beyond the area under the control of the licensee. (2) Any noise caused by

1 entertainment or amplified sound that is subject to the provisions of an active
2 Entertainment Permit issued by the San Francisco Entertainment Commission shall be
3 authorized in accordance with the limits established by that Entertainment Permit,
4 including any limitation on hours during which entertainment or amplified sound is
5 permitted. A violation of the entertainment or amplified sound noise conditions of the
6 Entertainment Permit, as determined by the San Francisco Entertainment Commission
7 (or any successor agency), shall be deemed to be a violation of this Condition. Any
8 noise that is not subject to, or is beyond the scope of, the Entertainment Permit shall be
9 subject to Condition 1 above. "Entertainment Permit" means any of the following: a Just
10 Add Music permit, a Limited Live Performance permit, a Place of Entertainment permit,
11 a Fixed Place Amplified Sound permit, or any similar such permit issued by the San
12 Francisco Entertainment Commission; and 4) At any time, the premise is providing live
13 entertainment, the petitioner(s) shall have two (2) uniformed security guard(s) on the
14 premises and shall maintain order therein to prevent any activity which would interfere
15 with the quiet enjoyment of their nearby residents, or the surrounding community. The
16 uniform security guards must be licensed by the State of California Department of
17 Consumer Affairs; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,
19 Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
20 hereby determines that issuance of a Type-90 on-sale general music venue liquor
21 license to SR Visions, LLC, to do business as 7 Social located at 65 Post Street, will
22 serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and,
23 be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of
25 San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police

1 Department listed above and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage
2 Control issue the license with those conditions.

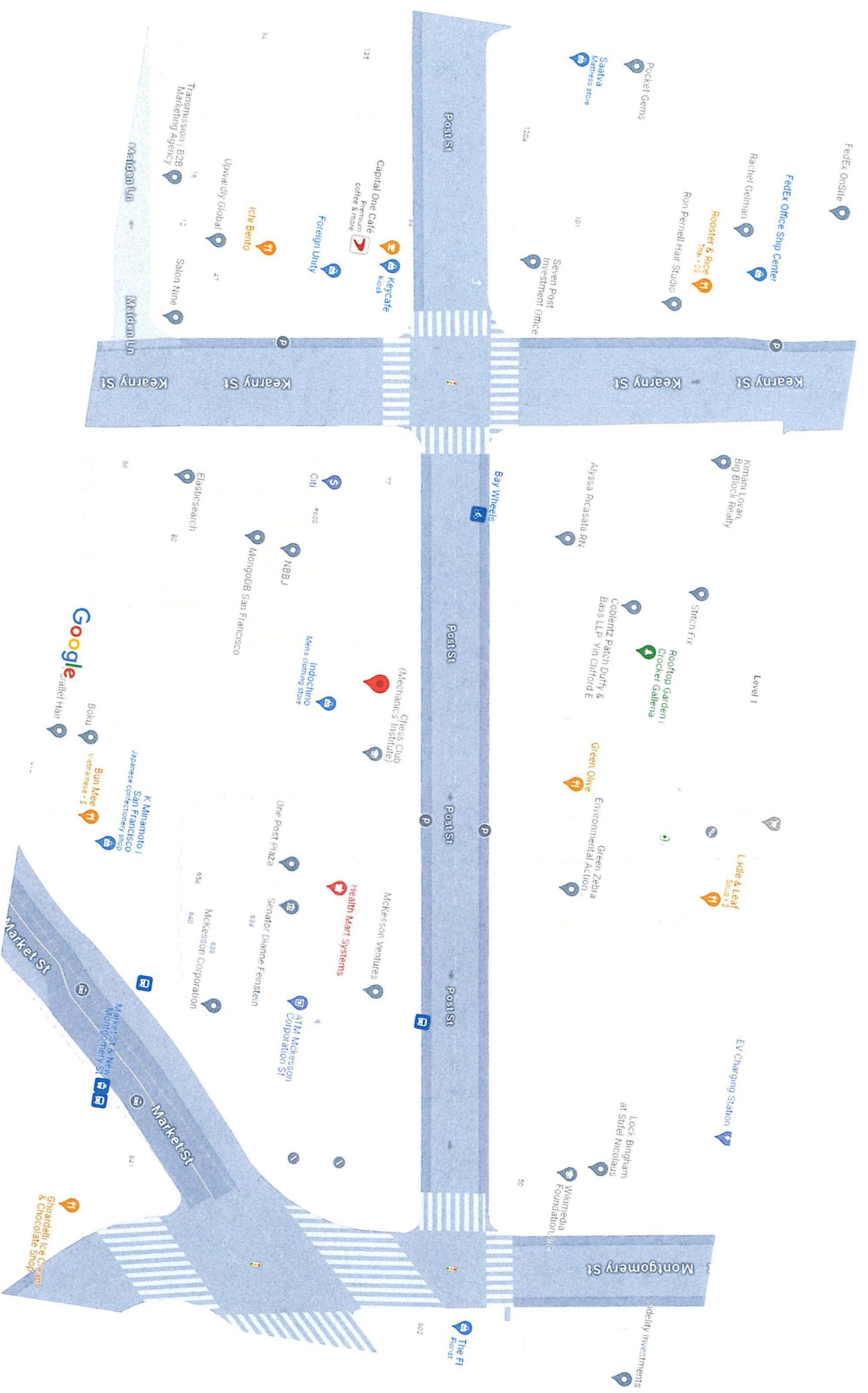

Dear Ms. Calvillo:

This office represents SR Visions dba 7 Social. My client has applied to the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) for an original Type-90 Music Venue General License. Currently : SR Visions is operating a music /entertainment venue at 177 Eddy Street and has lost their lease and wishes to move his business to this new location. Ther is no ABC license at this location, but prior to COVID-19 there was a Type -48 license at this bar. with no ABC license presently at this theater. The entertainment operation of the business under the proposed new ABC license will remain identical to the operation of their current Record Bar located at 177 Eddy St.

A Type-90 ABC license is a new license (2023) that authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits at retail for consumption on the premises of a music entertainment facility, as defined in Business and Professions Code Section 23550. Sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages are limited to the time period from 2 hours before a live performance until one hour after the live performance. Minors are allowed on the premises.

There are very few surrounding residences within 100 feet of this music venue and bar. The location has been a bar and lounge for several decades. This request is to allow SR Visions, LLC to add a Type-90 ABC license to the premises.

The area is zoned C-3-0 Downtown Office. We do not see any problems with the San Francisco Police Department approving this new ABC license, with conditions. We have the support for this

application from many of our neighbors, and are open to the imposition of conditions, if necessary, to this license. We have the support of this application, also, from local community and arts groups.

SR Visions is locally owned, and thus revenue and taxes from the business will stay in the community. This new license will allow SR Visions to move locations following loss of their lease and to remain open and viable, will sustain the pedestrian traffic to other businesses in the neighborhood, and keep more “eyes on the street” and make the neighborhood safer after 10 PM.

SR Visions has been well-managed by the current owners and non-problematic since 2019. The owner has owned and managed many venues over the past 20 years and there have been no noise complaints and minimal police issues since the business opened five years ago. My client will continue with this new ABC music venue license to be respectful to the neighborhood and to its customers. Foremost, they will be Good Neighbors.

For the reasons outlined above, applicant SR Visions dba 7 Social respectfully requests that this letter be forwarded to the Public Safety & Neighborhood Services Committee of the Board and that this Committee and the full Board of Supervisors make a determination under California Business and Professions Code Section 23958.4 that the public need or convenience would be served by allowing this new ABC Type-90 liquor license to issue at this location.

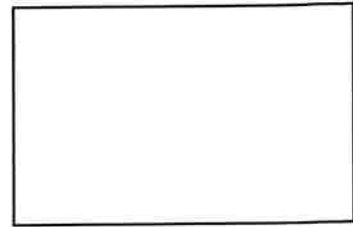
