

1 [Contract Amendment - Global Tel*Link - Inmate Welfare Fund - In Excess of
2 \$10,000,000]

4 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Sheriff's Department to amend the**
5 **existing contract with Global Tel*Link for inmate telephone services, which will**
6 **result in an anticipated commission to the Inmate Welfare Fund of more than**
7 **\$10,000,000 dollars over a five-year period from June 1, 2010, through May 31,**
8 **2014, with a one-year option to extend the term.**

10 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Sheriff's Department requested bids for Inmate
11 Telephone Services; and

12 WHEREAS, A five-member panel evaluated and scored the written proposals in
13 accordance with the City approved selection criteria; and

14 WHEREAS, The Human Rights Commission determined DBE/LBE subcontracting
15 goals do not apply; and

16 WHEREAS, Section 9.118 "Contract and Lease Limitations", Subsection (a)
17 requires Board of Supervisor's approval of any contract which, when entered into, has
18 anticipated revenue of one million dollars or more; and

19 WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department has an Inmate Welfare Fund, as provided
20 for in California Penal Code Section 5000-5030.1; and

21 WHEREAS, The current Global Tel*Link contract pays to the Sheriff's Inmate
22 Welfare Fund a commission of 60 percent of gross revenue sales; and

23 WHEREAS, The proposed Global Tel*Link amendment shall pay to the Sheriff's
24 Inmate Welfare Fund a commission of 65 percent of gross revenue sales, an increase of
25 five percent; and

1 WHEREAS, Global Tel*Link shall pay to the Sheriff's Inmate Welfare Fund an
2 additional \$100,000 payable thirty days from First Amendment execution; and

3 WHEREAS, The original contract agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board
4 of Supervisors in File No. 100442; and

5 WHEREAS, The amendment agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
6 Supervisors in File No. 130801, which is hereby declared to be part of this resolution as if
7 set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Inmate
9 Telephone Services Amendment by and between Gloabal Tel*Link, and the City and
10 County of San Francisco, acting by and through its Sheriff's Department, for a one year
11 contract extension, beginning June 1, 2013, with a one-year option exercisable by the
12 Sheriff's Department, and, be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the contract amendment
14 being fully executed by all parties, the Sherriff shall provide the final contract amendment
15 to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
