

1 [Accept-Expend State Grant]

2 AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT  
3 OF \$5,000,000 FROM THE STATE BOARD OF CORRECTIONS AND EXPEND THE  
4 AMOUNT OF \$910,148 FOR MENTALLY ILL OFFENDER CRIME REDUCTION  
5 DEMONSTRATION GRANT.

7 WHEREAS, Due to the deinstitutionalization of severely mentally  
8 ill individuals that occurred in the 1970's, many mentally ill people  
9 now remain untreated, resulting in impaired functioning, poverty,  
10 homelessness, and self-medication with alcohol and controlled  
11 substances; and,

12 WHEREAS, These behaviors often necessitate police intervention  
13 resulting in incarceration and, in some instances, sentencing to  
14 state prison; and,

15 WHEREAS, The State Board of Corrections has made available  
16 funding, in accordance with the provisions of Senate Bill 1485  
17 (Article 4 of Chapter 5 of Title 7 of Part 3 of the Penal Code), for  
18 development of programs designed to reduce jail crowding, crime and  
19 criminal justice costs while addressing the needs of mentally ill  
20 offenders during incarceration and upon release; and,

21 WHEREAS, The 1999-2000 State budget included an allocation of \$5  
22 million to the City and County of San Francisco for the purpose of  
23 demonstrating the effectiveness of interventions relating to mentally  
24 ill offenders who are likely to be committed to state prison; and,

1           WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors, in Resolution  
2 No. 133-99 (File 990340), authorized the Sheriff to submit and sign  
3 San Francisco's application for State funding as well as related  
4 contracts, amendments, or extensions with the State of California;  
5 and,

6           WHEREAS, A copy of the grant application and contract are on  
7 file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.           ;  
8 and,

9           WHEREAS, Indirect costs are included at the rate of two percent  
10 of the project grant; and,

11           WHEREAS, The grant proposal identifies hard matching funds  
12 consisting of \$987,510 in additional Medi-Cal/Federal funds expected  
13 to be generated through the services provided during the grant  
14 period; and,

15           WHEREAS, The proposal also identifies in-kind matching funds in  
16 the amount of \$1,311,344; and,

17           WHEREAS, The \$5,000,000 of State grant funds is allocated for  
18 expenditures of \$910,148 in fiscal year 1999-2000, \$1,324,084 in  
19 fiscal year 2000-2001, \$1,354,646 in fiscal year 2001-2002, and  
20 \$1,411,122 in fiscal year 2002-2003; and

21           WHEREAS, This grant shall be treated as a continuing grant as  
22 defined by Administrative Code Section 10.170, authorizing  
23 expenditure of \$910,148 for fiscal year 1999-2000 and providing for  
24 the request of expenditure authority in future years through  
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




3 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County




