3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Arts Commission to accept and expend a**
4 **grant in the amount of \$109,000 from the State of California Department of Parks and**
5 **Recreation for the Restoration of the James A. Garfield and the Guiseppe Verdi**
6 **Monuments in Golden Gate Park.**

8 WHEREAS, The Monuments in Golden Gate Park are in need of restoration and repair;
9 and,

10 WHEREAS, The monument to James A. Garfield has become a public hazard and the
11 Verdi monument badly corroded and unsightly; and,

12 WHEREAS, The State of California has agreed to provide monies from the State 2000
13 Bond Act for the restoration of these two monuments; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Arts Commission proposes to maximize use of available grant funds
15 on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore,
16 be it

17 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Arts Commission has a charter mandated
18 responsibility for the care and maintenance of works of art belonging to the City; and be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Arts Commission has an obligation to
20 complete the project as outlined in the Department of Parks and Recreation Grant Contract;
21 and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Arts Commission has demonstrated
23 experience and expertise in the conservation of public monuments; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Arts Commission respectfully
25 requests permission from the San Francisco Board of Supervisors to accept and expend the

1 grant from the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation 2000 Bond Act
2 Specified Grants for the Restoration of the James A. Garfield and Guiseppe Verdi monuments
3 in Golden Gate Park.
