

1 [Agreement Amendment- AT&T dba AT&T Mobility - Public Safety-Grade Wireless  
2 Communications Services - Not to Exceed \$22,252,968]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Technology approving the first amendment**  
4 **with AT&T dba AT&T Mobility to purchase public safety-grade wireless**  
5 **communications services for first responders with no change to the term of up to**  
6 **five years and four months, increasing the agreement amount by \$13,252,968 for a**  
7 **total contract amount of \$22,252,968 pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118.**

9 WHEREAS, On June 23, 2020, the Department of Technology (“Department”)  
10 entered into an agreement for the City and County of San Francisco (“City”) to purchase  
11 public safety-grade wireless communications services for first responders (“First Net  
12 Services”) from AT&T dba AT&T Mobility (“AT&T Mobility”) in reliance upon the competitive  
13 procurement process of the FirstNet Authority and using the directly negotiated California  
14 Network and Telecommunications (“CALNET”) FirstNet Contract C3A2FN9-18 of the  
15 California Department of Technology for FirstNet Services awarded to AT&T Mobility (“AT&T  
16 Mobility FirstNet Agreement”), pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 21.16(b); and

17 WHEREAS, The AT&T Mobility FirstNet Agreement had a term of five years and four  
18 months (through October 21, 2025) and a not to exceed amount of \$9,000,000; and

19 WHEREAS, In part due to the Covid-19 pandemic, City departments have authorized  
20 more City first responders to use FirstNet Services than the Department anticipated when it  
21 entered into this agreement; and

22 WHEREAS, The Department has evaluated the City’s needs for FirstNet Services  
23 from AT&T Mobility during the term of the AT&T Mobility FirstNet Agreement; the Department  
24 has determined that the City’s spending under the AT&T Mobility FirstNet Agreement during  
25 the term could be in excess of \$22 million; and

1           WHEREAS, The Department and AT&T Mobility have entered into a First Amendment  
2 to the AT&T Mobility FirstNet Agreement that will increase the not to exceed amount to  
3 \$22,252,968, a copy of the First Amendment is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
4 Supervisors in File No. 230051; and

5           WHEREAS, Section 9.118 of the San Francisco Charter requires approval by the Board  
6 of Supervisors for contracts requiring expenditures above \$10,000,000; now, therefore, be it

7           RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the First Amendment to the  
8 AT&T FirstNet Agreement between the City and AT&T Mobility to allow City departments to  
9 continue to purchase FirstNet services from AT&T Mobility with a not to exceed amount of  
10 \$22,252,968; and, be it

11           FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the First Amendment being fully  
12 executed by the parties the Department of Technology shall provide a copy of it to the Clerk  
13 of the Board for inclusion in the official file.
