

1 [Contract funds to conduct interviews and obtain data regarding pre-exposure prophylaxis use
2 by MSM.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH), to**
4 **enter retroactively into a subcontract agreement with Public Health Foundation**
5 **Enterprises, Inc. (PHFE), the primary contractor, and expend funds in the amount of**
6 **\$16,073 to conduct interviews and obtain data on pre-exposure prophylaxis use by**
7 **MSM for the period of January 1, 2006, to April 30, 2006.**

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9 WHEREAS, PHFE is the recipient of contract funds from the Universitywide AIDS
10 Research Program (UARP) to participate in a research study, “Pre Exposure Prophylaxis Use
11 Among MSM in the SF Bay Area”; and,

12 WHEREAS, This research study is under the technical leadership of the San Francisco
13 City and County of San Francisco Health Department (SFDPH); and,

14 WHEREAS, SFDPH and PHFE have agreed to enter into an agreement to participate
15 in this study; and,

16 WHEREAS, PHFE has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$16,073 to
17 participate in this study; and,

18 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving these funds, PHFE requires SFDPH to enter
19 into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
20 Supervisors in File No. _____; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
21 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

22 WHEREAS, The subcontract agreement budget includes provision for indirect costs of
23 \$2,695; and,

24 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors
25 because we did not receive the subcontract agreement until December, 2005; and,

1 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
2 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
3 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
4 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract
6 agreement in the amount of \$16,073 with PHFE, the primary contractor; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
8 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions
10 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
11 the agreement expires.
