## Accessible Meeting Information

Hearings will be held at City Hall, #1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, 4<sup>th</sup> floor. Accessible seating for persons with disabilities, including those using wheelchairs will be available.

The closest accessible BART Station is Civic Center, located at the intersection of Market and 8th Streets, three blocks from City Hall. Accessible MUNI bus lines serving the City Hall area are: 5 Fulton, 6 Parnassus, 9 San Bruno, 19 Polk, 21 Hayes, 47 Van Ness, 49 Van Ness-Mission, and 7 Haight/Noriega. Accessible MUNI Metro lines are: F, J, K, L, M, N, T (exit at Civic Center or Van Ness Stations). Accessible curbside parking is available on Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, Grove Street, McAllister Street, and Van Ness Avenue. There is also accessible parking in the vicinity of City Hall at Civic Center Plaza and adjacent to Davies Hall and the War Memorial Complex.

Minutes of the meeting are available in alternative formats.
