9 WHEREAS, This new 3,600 square foot child care facility will serve 51 children,
10 including infants, toddlers, and pre-schoolers; and,

11 WHEREAS, These children are a combination of children of City employees and
12 children from the community and neighborhoods; and,

13 WHEREAS, Marin Day Schools, a public nonprofit corporation, will operate the child
14 care facility in accordance with their philosophy to provide children with the nurturing, respect,
15 education, and support they rightfully deserve; and,

16 WHEREAS, The San Francisco City Hall Child Care Center will provide a curriculum
17 that is developmental, engaging, multi-cultural, anti-bias, informative, relevant, and fun; and,

18 WHEREAS, The San Francisco City Hall Child Care Center believes in child care that
19 is responsive to the challenging needs of society and family life; and,

20 WHEREAS, Between 5,000 and 6,000 children are still on a waiting list for child care in
21 San Francisco; and,

22 WHEREAS, The opening of the San Francisco City Hall Child Care Center
23 demonstrates the City's commitment to affordable, accessible, and high-quality child care for
24 all San Francisco children; now, therefore, be it


