WHEREAS, Carlos was born and raised in Mexico where he was introduced to traditional music by his father, who taught Carlos the basics of music theory; and,

WHEREAS, when Carlos' family moved to Tijuana he began playing guitar, emulating bluesmen John Lee Hooker and B.B. King, and soon after was playing with local bands along the "Tijuana Strip"; and,

WHEREAS, When in 1960 Carlos' family moved to San Francisco, Carlos continued his developing his own unique musical style; and,

WHEREAS, Santana's group started with Mission District jams, debuted in 1966 at the Fillmore West in San Francisco, and ended the decade with their Latin-flavored rock sound that electrified Woodstock in 1969; and,

WHEREAS, Carlos has always been dedicated to the development of his musical expression from the double-platinum debut album "Santana" and the quadruple-platinum follow-up "Abraxas" to his collaboration with Jazz greats Buddy Miles, Wayne Shorter as well as with Brazilian artists Airto Moreira and Flora Purim; and,

WHEREAS, Carlos has received ten Bammies (including six Best Guiatrist and three Musician of the Year) and in 1997, was inducted into the Bammy Hall of Fame; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commends Carlos Santana for his success at the Grammy Awards and his outstanding musical achievements for the past 30 years; and, be it
