

[Apply for, Accept, and Expend Grant - U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development
Emergency Solutions Grants Program - \$1,712,613 - FY2026-2027]

**Resolution approving the Fiscal Year (FY) 2026-2027 Emergency Solutions Grants
(ESG) Program; and authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the City and County of San
Francisco, to apply for, accept, and expend the City's FY2026-2027 ESG Program
entitlement from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, in
the amount of \$1,712,613 for an unspecified period starting July 1, 2026.**

WHEREAS, Under the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act and Cranston
Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, the Secretary of the United States
Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is authorized to make a grant to the
City and County of San Francisco under the Emergency Solutions Grants Program (ESG);
and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco anticipates receiving \$1,712,613 in
FY2026-2027 ESG Program funds from HUD; and

WHEREAS, The Citizen's Committee on Community Development (CCCD) has
prepared recommendations for ESG funding as set forth in a proposed Expenditure Schedule,
a copy of which is located in Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 260370; and

WHEREAS, The ESG Program funds will be used to provide for the payment of certain
operating and social service expenses in connection with emergency shelters and for
homeless prevention activities; and

WHEREAS, The proposed grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance
amendment; and

WHEREAS, Receipt of the ESG funds requires the City to match 100% of funds
provided by HUD; and

1 WHEREAS, The funding agency (HUD) does not allow use of the grant on indirect
2 costs; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco is hereby
4 authorized to apply for, accept, and expend the City's FY2026-2027 ESG Program entitlement
5 from HUD in accordance with the purposes and goals for the funding as generally set forth in
6 the 2025-29 Five-Year Consolidated Plan and the Expenditure Schedule; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the
8 purposes and goals for FY2026-2027 ESG Program funding as set forth in the Expenditure
9 Schedule for recipient agencies and departments; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
11 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into and execute
13 agreements between the City and County of San Francisco and various agencies consistent
14 with the ESG Program and the Expenditure Schedule; and, be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit documentation
16 and certifications as may be requested or required by HUD, and to take such additional
17 actions as may be required to apply for, accept and expend the ESG funds consistent with
18 this Resolution and the goals of the ESG Program and all applicable legal requirements, and
19 any such actions are solely intended to further the purposes of this Resolution, and are
20 subject in all respect to the terms of this Resolution, and any such action cannot increase the
21 risk to the City, or require the City to expend any resources, and that the Mayor shall consult
22 with the City Attorney prior to execution and provided that within 30 days of the agreements
23 approved by this Resolution being executed by all parties, such final documents (showing
24 marked changes, if any) shall be provided to the Clerk of the Board, for inclusion in the official

1 file, together with a brief explanation of any actions from the date of the adoption of this
2 Resolution; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That all actions heretofore taken by the officers of the City
4 with respect to the application for, or the acceptance or expenditure of, ESG funds, as
5 consistent with the documents herein and this Resolution, are hereby approved, confirmed
6 and ratified.
