[FEDERAL FUNDING – ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE (EDI)-SPECIAL PROJECTS]
, RETROACTIVELY,
AUTHORIZING/THE MAYOR OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO ACCEPT
AND EXPEND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE (EDI)-SPECIAL PROJECT FUNDS IN A
TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$700,000 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING
AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD).

WHEREAS, the U.S. Congress has directed HUD to provide funding from the EDI account for
certain EDI-Special Projects, pursuant to the VA-HUD-Independent Agencies Appropriations Act of
1999, and these projects are specified in House Report No. 105-769, which is the Conference Report on
the 1999 Appropriations Act for HUD and other agencies (P.L. 105-276); and

WHEREAS, the Conference Report specifies \$700,000 for the City and County of San Francisco
for community revitalization efforts in the Visitacion Valley neighborhood; and


WHEREAS, the EDI-Special Project funds will be used for capital-related costs of five new
community facilities, in accordance with overall revitalization efforts in the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Office of Community Development has prepared a description of the
proposed use of EDI-Special Project funds for the five community facilities; and


WHEREAS, indirect costs have been covered in the 1999 Community Development Block Grant
Program; now, therefore, be it

, retroactively,
RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize/the Mayor to accept and
expend \$700,000 of EDI-Special Project funds from HUD for community revitalization efforts in the
Visitacion Valley neighborhood.


