4 **general public premises liquor license from 1525 Mission Street to 1525 Mission**

7 **serve the public convenience or necessity of the people of the City and County of**

11 WHEREAS, Mark E. Renne is seeking a transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general
12 public premises liquor license from 1525 Mission Street to 1525 Mission Street for
13 expansion of public occupancy into adjacent portion of the building, for ZFC Concepts,
14 LLC, dba Sloane Square[d]; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
16 zoned and recommends approval; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license
18 application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business
20 and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
21 Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 48

5 be sufficient to maintain order therein and prevent any activity which would interfere with
6 the quiet enjoyment of their property by nearby residents. Said personnel shall be
7 readily identifiable as security personnel. In addition, security personnel shall make
8 frequent visits to areas, including parking lots, to ensure patrons from the premises do
9 not disturb the peace, quiet and comfort of persons in the neighborhood. (2) The
10 petitioner shall utilize electronic surveillance and recording equipment that is able to
11 view all exits and entrance points of the exterior of the premises. The electronic
12 surveillance/recording shall be operational at all times that the premises are open to the
13 public. Said electronic recording shall be maintained for no less than 72 hours and shall
14 be made available to the Department or Police Department upon demand. (3) Any
15 door(s) or window(s) that opens to Minna Street shall be kept closed at all times during
16 the operation of the premises and shall not be used as an entrance or exit for patrons.

Dear Ms. Cavillo:

This office represents ZFC Concepts, LLC dba **Sloane Square[d]**. My clients have applied to the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) for a premise to premise transfer of their On-Sale General Public Premises license. This premise to premise transfer is to allow applicant to operate and sell alcohol beverages to the public in an expanded portion of their building at 1525 Mission Street, San Francisco. The expansion space of the 1525 Mission building was previously occupied by Paige Gallery. Since May 2009, my client has operated a type-48 on-sale general ABC license on their original premises at the same address.

My client has received a Certificate of Occupancy from the SF Department of Building Inspection and an assembly permit from SF Fire Department to allow use of the expansion portion of the building for public occupancy. This request is for a certificate of public convenience ("PCN") required before the ABC will permit my client's ABC license privileges to cover the original and expansion area.

Sloane Square[d] ("Sloane") currently holds a valid Place of Entertainment license on the original premises, which allows them to provide live and DJ music to their patrons until 2 am. **Sloane** is scheduled to appear before the San Francisco Entertainment Commission on January 10, 2012 for approval of its current Place of Entertainment permit to allow entertainment in the expanded area of the establishment.

As part of its commitment to ensure that its operation in the expanded premises did not disturb its neighbors, **Sloane** has spent in excess of \$150,000 on sound mitigation measures. That work was designed by Charles Salter, a professor of Architectural Acoustics at UC Berkeley College of Environmental Design. On December 29, 2011, the music system for the entire club was given a sound test by the Entertainment Commission sound inspector, Vaj Grinelli, and easily passed. This sound test showed no sound bleed into any adjoining business or residence. **Sloane** will use a sound limiter to ensure that its music will not disturb the neighboring residences.

Sloane Square[d]'s mission is to provide a standard of excellence unparalleled in San Francisco nightlife, and it is devoted to participating in the improvement of its community. Along with providing employment to 40 hard-working and responsible individuals, **Sloane Square[d]** is developing a series of events that will provide a platform for non-profit organizations to network and fundraise. This platform will open the doors for dialogue between businesses and communities to discuss and come up with different ways of integrating the benefits of commerce with the educational and social concerns and community needs that the non-profit sector champions.

Sloane Square[d] has provided its venue for meetings and gatherings for the Lafayette, Minna, Natoma Neighborhood Association, of which it is a proud participating member. It has also hosted a number of benefits, including "*Hoodie People*", where sweatshirts, jackets and hooded sweaters were collected for donation to the Second Annual Hoodies Drive benefiting *St. Anthony's Foundation*. **Sloane** also supports *100 Black Men of America, Inc.*, an organization committed to utilizing the talents of its members to motivate and empower at-risk children and people to achieve and become self-sufficient contributors economically and socially to their communities. Supporting these groups—and many other non-profits—is part of the standard of excellence **Sloane Square[d]** promotes and embodies.


The approval by the Board of Supervisors of **Sloane's** expanded ABC licensed-premises would not have any detrimental effect on the surrounding neighborhood or the City of San Francisco. The clientele of this operation fit well into the existing neighborhood and have posed no public safety problems. This expansion will also provide additional job opportunities to the community.

1. The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premise is strictly prohibited.
2. No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the license as defined on the ABC-257 dated 07/18/2008.
3. No person under the age of twenty-one (21 years of age) shall sell, furnish, or deliver alcoholic beverages.
4. There shall be no coin operated games or video machines maintained upon the premises at any time.
5. Loitering (loitering as defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the license premises under the control of the licensee.
6. The petitioners shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premise over which they have control.
7. Graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots under the control of the licensee within 72 hrs of application. If the graffiti occurs on a Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti within 72 hours following the beginning of the next weekday.
8. Petitioners shall not make structural changes in the premise interior without prior written approval from the Department.
9. The interior lighting maintained therein shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons in that portion of the premises where alcoholic beverages are sold, served, delivered or consumed
10. The exterior of the premise shall be equipped with lighting sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residence.
11. At no time shall any persons under the age of 21 enter or remain in this public premise.

This petition for conditional license is made pursuant to the provisions of Sections 23800 through 23805 of the Business and Professions Code and will be carried forward in any transfer at the applicant-premises.

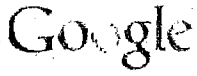

In addition, their patrons have been a hardship on the community. We have had problems with patrons exiting the club and being loud and disruptive, urinating, fighting, and engaging in sexual activity in parking lots and streets visible from my home.

Sloane has yet to address these issues which impact their neighbors. Until they do in a permanent fashion we don't believe it is appropriate to grant them a permanent license.
