A copy of said legislation is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 120883 and is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, On or about September 14, 2012, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors referred the proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinance; and
