[Commemorative Street Name Designation - "Panos Place" - 100-200 Block of Corbett Avenue]

Resolution adding the commemorative street name "Panos Place" to Corbin Place between the 100 and 200 block of Corbett Avenue in recognition of San Francisco resident Panagiotis Koutsoyannis.

WHEREAS, Corbett Heights Neighbors, a Corona Heights neighborhood association formed in 2004, has formally requested that San Francisco rename Corbin Place, a short stairway with gardens located perpendicular to, and between, Corbett Avenue and 17th Street in the Corona Heights neighborhood of the City, to honor long time San Francisco resident Panagiotis Koutoyannis, aka "Panos"; and

WHEREAS, Corbin Place is not a street; rather, it is a 60 foot stairway of 40 concrete steps perpendicular to and linking the 100-200 block of Corbett Avenue to the 4000th block of 17th Street; with two gardens, each 21 feet wide on both sides of the stairway; located on Department of Public Works property without any houses or structures accessible from Corbin Place; and is generally identified on internet- accessible maps as the "Corbin Stairs;" and

WHEREAS, From the "S.F. Board of Supervisors Proceedings N.S 4" from 1909, Corbin Place was dedicated and so named on 8 December 1909 (San Francisco Bill 1117, Ordinance No. 988); and

WHEREAS, Diligent research has not conclusively confirmed the identity of the person, if any, for which Corbin Place was named, speculation is that it may be for a Major General Corbin who was born in Ohio but visited San Francisco for ten days, arriving on October 6 of 1904, while en route to the U.S. colony of the Philippines where he was to assume a position as a Commander, this according to the San Francisco Chronicle in its edition of October 6, 1904; and

WHEREAS, Diligent research has failed to unearth any other indicia of San Francisco related civic accomplishments of said Major Corbin or any contributions he might have made to the betterment or history of the City; and

WHEREAS, Panagiotis Koutoyannis has lived in a residence that abuts the west side garden of Corbin Place since 2009; and

WHEREAS, The stairway and the two gardens of Corbin Place were not regularly maintained by the City until Mr. Koutoyannis commenced to do so in 2011, and thereafter he continuously replanted and maintained the gardens; installed lights, seasonal decorations, and an irrigation system; and added notable historical and San Francisco-specific artwork to the gardens; and

WHEREAS, Thanks to the past and continuing work of Mr. Koutoyannis, all at his own expense, the two gardens at Corbin Place are stunning and beautiful islands of green, light, and delight to adults and children alike, as well as to the many Muni riders who regularly use the stairs to access the 37 bus on Corbett Avenue; and

WHEREAS, In 2019 Corbett Heights Neighbors honored Mr. Koutoyannis for his extraordinary work and generous contribution to the neighborhood by hosting an event in his honor there, an event attended by scores of neighbors; and

WHEREAS, In view of the generous contribution of Mr. Koutoyannis, in both money and time, in gifting the neighborhood this exceptional, peaceful, and beautiful island of green and whimsy between two well-travelled traffic arteries, Corbett Avenue and 17th Street; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests the Municipal Transportation

Agency to erect street signs at Corbin Place, located between the 100 and 200 block of

Corbett Avenue, indicating both the honorary and the existing names of the street, either on a
