

1 [Accept-Expend Federal Grant – Disability and Healthcare Insurance Fraud Program]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the District Attorney of the City and County**
4 **of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$100,000**
5 **through the California Department of Insurance for a program entitled “Disability and**
6 **Healthcare Insurance Fraud Program” for fiscal year 2006/2007.**

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8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to establish a certain
9 project designated the Disability and Healthcare Insurance Fraud Program to be funded in
10 part from funds made available through the California Department of Insurance (hereafter
11 “DOI”); and,

12 WHEREAS, The terms of the grant prohibit inclusion of indirect costs in the grant
13 budget; now, therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of
15 the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend funds from DOI for
16 the purposes of investigation and prosecution of disability and healthcare insurance fraud;
17 and, be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
19 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of
21 the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for disability
22 and healthcare insurance fraud prosecution purposes, including any extensions,
23 augmentations or amendments thereof; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized and empowered to
25 execute, deliver and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all

1 applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary for the
2 purpose of securing disability and healthcare insurance fraud grant funds and to implement
3 and carry out the purposes specified in the applicable grant application; and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant
5 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the
6 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and that the grant recipient and the authorizing
7 agency will hold DOI harmless from any claims that may arise from the use of grant funds; be
8 it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
10 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
