## Resolution honoring Jane Morrison on the occasion of her 90<sup>th</sup> birthday.

WHEREAS, In her 58 years as a resident of San Francisco, Jane Morrison has left an indelible mark on our City's politics, policy, culture and community; and

WHEREAS, Born in Hackberry Flat, Oklahoma and raised by a dedicated mother who was an active Roosevelt Democrat, Jane's marriage to Jack Morrison, who would later become a member and President of the Board of Supervisors, and her pursuit of journalism, led her to San Francisco in 1952; and,

WHEREAS, Unable to further her chosen journalism career due to gender discrimination, Jane established a successful career in public affairs radio while pursuing her passion for politics after hours; and

WHEREAS, Jane's work on behalf of candidates and issues from the 1950s through today including a term as Chair of the Women's Caucus of the California Democratic Party, service as Chair of the San Francisco Democratic Party, and continued involvement as an elected member of the San Francisco Democratic County Central Committee have helped shape San Francisco's progressive agenda; and

WHEREAS, Jane has committed her enormous time and talent to the welfare of San Francisco in her leadership role in pursuing environmental, charitable, and social justice issues, through service as President of the City's Human Service Commission and San Francisco Tomorrow, and as a leader in the Friends of the Human Rights Commission, City College Foundation, Radio-TV Public Affairs Directors, and Chinese Newcomers Service Center; now, therefore, be it
