

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - California Victim Compensation and Government Claims
2 Board - Criminal Restitution Compact - Not to Exceed \$267,372]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept**
4 **and expend a grant in the amount of \$89,124 from the California Victim**
5 **Compensation and Government Claims Board for the period of July 1, 2016,**
6 **through June 30, 2017; authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept**
7 **and expend a grant in the amount of \$89,124 for the period of July 1, 2017,**
8 **through June 30, 2018; and an amount of \$89,124 for the period of July 1, 2018,**
9 **through June 30, 2019, for a total not to exceed amount of \$267,372 to continue**
10 **the Criminal Restitution Compact should the parties agree to an amendment as**
11 **allowed under the provisions of the grant agreement.**

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13 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to enter into an
14 agreement with the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board in
15 accordance with Government Code, Section 13835 for the purpose of ensuring that
16 restitution fines and orders are properly administered; and

17 WHEREAS, Funds received shall not be used to supplant local funds that would,
18 in the absence of California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board
19 Programs, be made available to support the assistance of victims and witnesses of
20 crime; and

21 WHEREAS, The grant amount represents an increase of \$3,466 per year than
22 what the Board of Supervisors have already approved in the District Attorney's budget;
23 and

24 WHEREAS, The resolution is presented at the request of the grantor-California
25 Victim Compensation and Government Claims board; and

1 WHEREAS, All positions supported by these funds shall be coded “G” in the
2 District Attorney’s budget; and

3 WHEREAS, The District Attorney proposes to maximize use of available grant
4 funds for program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; and

5 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an amendment to the Annual Salary
6 Ordinance (ASO); now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the District Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco,
8 or his designee, is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to
9 contract for, and accept and expend funds from the California Victim Compensation and
10 Government Claims Board to continue the Criminal Restitution Compact, including any
11 extensions, augmentations or amendments thereof; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion
13 of indirect costs in the grant budget.
