

1 [Contract funds to develop an on-line collaborative HIV trial training resource center.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
4 **enter retroactively into an agreement with Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc.**
5 **(PHFE), the primary contractor, and expend funds in the amount of \$74,732 for services**
6 **under the agreement; for the period of September 1, 2003 to August 31, 2004.**

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8 WHEREAS, PHFE has been retained by the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center
9 to participate in a project to develop an on line collaborative HIV Trial Training Resource
10 Center under the technical leadership of the San Francisco City and County Health
11 Department; and,

12 WHEREAS, PHFE and SFDPH have agreed to enter into a subcontract agreement to
13 participate in this project; and,

14 WHEREAS, PHFE has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$74,732 under
15 the terms of this subcontract; and,

16 WHEREAS, The services of Dr. Jonathan Fuchs, MD, MPH, AIDS Office, San
17 Francisco City and County Health Department, will be supported through this project; and,

18 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds PHFE requires SFDPH to enter into
19 an agreement (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
20 Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
21 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

22 WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$10,308;
23 now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract
25 agreement in the amount of \$74,732 with PHFE, the primary contractor; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
2 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded
4 under this agreement as a “G” or grant-funded position which would terminate when the
5 agreement expires.
