2 URGING THAT THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) NOT ADOPT ANY  
3 PAST, PRESENT OR FUTURE AIRCRAFT PROCEDURES WHICH WILL INCREASE NOISE  
4 OR SHIFT AIRCRAFT NOISE AND WILL ADOPT ALL PAST, PRESENT OR FUTURE  
5 AIRCRAFT PROCEDURES WHICH WILL DECREASE AIRCRAFT NOISE IN THE CITY  
6 AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO.

8 WHEREAS, The quality of life for the residents and the quality  
9 of the business environment in San Francisco need to be preserved in  
10 all ways; and,

11 WHEREAS, The air space over the City and County of San Francisco  
12 needs to be preserved without undue and increased overflights by  
13 aircraft procedures from all airports and aircraft operations; and,

14 WHEREAS, San Francisco International Airport (SFIA) has  
15 completed a feasibility study which has determined that a runway  
16 reconfiguration system is needed to: reduce aircraft noise in all  
17 surrounding communities; eliminate delays to aircraft during  
18 inclement weather; accommodate new large aircraft anticipated in  
19 approximately six years; and provide a net gain in bay preservation  
20 and wildlife habitat through mitigation of a runway reconfiguration  
21 project; and,

22 WHEREAS, San Francisco International Airport (SFIA) will need to  
23 proceed with a specific plan and environmental review process for a  
24 runway reconfiguration; and,




