Re: Type 48 liquor license for Project One Gallery

Since its inception in 2008, Project One Gallery has provided a unique and sophisticated venue for artists and art lovers in San Francisco. Located in the design district of the city on Rhode Island St between 15th and 16th in an old showroom space, Project One embodies many aspects of the spirit of the neighborhood. The design of the space is sophisticated and elegant. A dedicated gallery space at the front of building leads to an intimate lounge area and bar.

The area is bustling during the day with many people stopping by to view the gallery. At night the area is sleepy with little walk up traffic. We have never tried nor do we intend to try to become a "local" hangout in the evening - rather our focus is on art driven destination and private events.

Since 2008 Project One has operated with a beer and wine license. A large majority of the current revenue comes from private events and our intention with the full liquor license is to increase our ability to offer sophisticated private events to local corporations, organizations and individuals. In many cases our ability to close deals is hampered by our current alcohol license - i.e. clients choose other venues with full liquor licenses.

Project One Gallery is serious about the arts. We have worked with many local artists over the last 3 years - showing an average of 10 shows a year. Our Director and partner, Brooke Waterhouse was recently appointed to the Executive Board of the Yerba Buena Center for the Arts in San Francisco and is now actively working to boost the profile of arts not just at Project One Gallery but city wide through YBCA.

Project One Gallery is also serious about business. Our Managing Director and Partner, Steve Waterhouse is a technology entrepreneur and veteran of many local startups. He is currently CTO of RPX Corporation based in San Francisco. We believe his strong links with local

businesses including Zynga, Fuse Project, Incase and Adobe will prove advantageous to our business.

The husband and wife team of Steve and Brooke is supplemented by a strong and loyal staff. Many of our staff have artistic ambitions and have featured work in our gallery and curated shows over the last year.

Finally, Project One Gallery has been a huge supported of local, national and international charities and non profits. We regularly donate our space to charities and non profits and also have raised money via art and bar sales. A list of some of the non profits and charities we have supported is in Appendix 1 of this letter.

We ask for your support in our application for a full liquor license for Project One Gallery which we believe will benefit the local neighborhood, community, businesses and the overall city of San Francisco.
