[Execution of Homeland Security Grants]

Resolution authorizing designated City and County of San Francisco officials to execute and file, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining federal financial assistance provided by the federal Department of Homeland Security, and sub-granted through the State of California under various grant programs, including: 1) FY2011 Homeland Security Grant Program, for the FY2011 Urban Areas Security Initiative grant; 2) FY2011 Regional Catastrophic Preparedness Grant Program; 3) FY2011 State Homeland Security Grant Program (which includes the Metropolitan Medical Response System and Citizen Corps Programs); 4) FY2011 Emergency Management Performance Grant; and 5) Public Law 112-10.

WHEREAS, The State of California, through various homeland security grant programs, provides support for the development and maintenance of the capability of local jurisdictions to prepare for and respond to natural disasters, acts of terrorism, and other manmade disasters and provides for the dispersal of federal funds provided for this purpose under Public law 112-10; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has participated in these programs since their inception and deems participation in these programs as vital to the continued well-being of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, The State of California requires that applicant's agents be named in the resolution, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the Executive Director of the Department of Emergency Management, or in his or her absence, the Chief Financial Officer of the Department of Emergency Management, or the Deputy Director of the Department of Emergency Management, or General Manager of the Bay Area UASI or the Director of Strategy and Compliance of the Bay Area UASI, to execute for and on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining federal financial assistance provided by the federal Department of Homeland Security and subgranted through the State of California under the FY 11 Homeland Security Grant Program for the FY 11 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) grant, the FY 11 Regional Catastrophic Preparedness Grant Program (RCPGP), the FY 11 State Homeland Security Grant Program (which includes the Metropolitan Medical Response System and Citizen Corps Programs), the FY 11 Emergency Management Performance Grant, and Public Law 112-10.


