

1 [Adopting the State of California’s Energy Priorities: energy efficiency and demand response,  
2 renewable energy and lastly clean fossil generation]

3 **Resolution adopting the State of California’s Energy Priorities as stated in the Energy**  
4 **Action Plan of 2003 and Energy Action Plan II of 2005 which are, in the following order,**  
5 **energy efficiency and demand response, renewable energy and lastly clean fossil**  
6 **generation.**

8 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco is  
9 deeply concerned about global warming and air pollution; and

10 WHEREAS, fossil fuel-burning power plants emit millions of tons of carbon dioxide, the  
11 compound primarily responsible for global warming, into our atmosphere each year; and;

12 WHEREAS the State of California has adopted an Energy Action Plan that lays out the  
13 energy priorities for the state

14 WHEREAS, those energy priorities are, in the following order, energy efficiency and  
15 demand response, use of renewable energy including solar, wind and geothermal and lastly  
16 clean burning fossil generation; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco adopts the State’s Energy  
18 Action Plan and the priorities held therein; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco adopts the same  
20 priorities: energy efficiency and demand response first, then renewable and lastly clean  
21 burning fossil generation.
