4 WHEREAS, Kathleen Robinson Munson received her teaching credential from San
5 Francisco State University and became the second African American teacher hired by the
6 San Francisco Unified School District beginning her distinguished teaching career at Raphael
7 Weill Elementary School in 1943; and,

8 WHEREAS, After beginning her career teaching third and fourth graders, Ms. Munson
9 was assigned to teach kindergarten which she taught until she left Raphael Weill after 26
10 years; and,

11 WHEREAS, Shortly thereafter, Ms. Munson became a Community Teacher at John
12 Muir Elementary School where she involved herself with parents, children and worked with a
13 non-profit organization benefiting the less fortunate members of the Fillmore/Haight
14 community; and,

15 WHEREAS, In her role as an educator and mentor, Ms. Munson touched countless
16 lives and gave generations of San Franciscans the daring to become all that they could be it;
17 now, therefore be it

18 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby urges the San
19 Francisco Unified School District to rename Golden Gate Elementary School Kathleen
20 Robinson Munson School.
