

## Small Business Commission Recommendations Local Relief - Economic Recovery Task Force



- Expand the commercial eviction moratorium through the end of the calendar year.
- Connect small business owners with free or low-cost legal services who can advise on lease negotiation.
- The City should incentivize property owners to abate rent owed during SIP for their commercial tenants. An example: allow property owners to deduct from their gross receipts the amount of rent waived or reduced.
