

1 [Study of at-risk and HIV positive youth in San Francisco.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
4 **enter retroactively into an agreement in the amount of \$19,800 with The Regents of the**
5 **University of California San Francisco (UCSF), the primary contractor, to participate in**
6 **a study of at-risk and HIV positive youth in San Francisco, for the period of March 1,**
7 **2003, to February 29, 2004.**

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9 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the DHHS National Institutes
10 of Health (NIH) for the conduct of a program entitled “A San Francisco Street Youth Cohort:
11 At-Risk and HIV+” as part of a national adolescent trials network (ATN); and,

12 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interests of NIH, UCSF, and SFDPH to
13 participate in this project; and,

14 WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$19,800 under
15 the terms of this agreement; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires SFDPH to enter into a
17 subcontract (The “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
18 Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
19 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

20 WHEREAS, The contract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$1,800; and,

21 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors
22 because we did not receive the agreement until July 17, 2003; and,

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1 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
2 may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
3 considered to be routine items, and the resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
4 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract
6 agreement in the amount of \$19,800 with UCSF, the primary contractor, for services under the
7 program entitled "A San Francisco Street Youth Cohort: At-Risk and HIV+"; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
9 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
11 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
12 the agreement expires.
