

1 [Waiver of Banner Fee - APA Family Support Services]

3 **Ordinance retroactively authorizing the installation of up to six banners on City-owned**
4 **utility poles by APA Family Support Services under Public Works Code, Section 184.78,**
5 **at 1652 Sunnysdale Avenue between August 1, 2017, and January 31, 2018; and waiving**
6 **the fees for those banners.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

14 Section 1. Findings.

15 (a) APA Family Support Services (“APA”) is celebrating its 30th anniversary of
16 providing services to at-risk Asian and Pacific Islander children and their families in San
17 Francisco. APA’s mission is to create healthy families by providing domestic violence and
18 child abuse prevention services through case management and other services at the
19 organization’s family resource centers. APA now has eight offices in five neighborhoods
20 throughout the City—including a main location in Chinatown and three in Visitacion Valley—
21 and provides outreach and services to over 7,000 families each year.

22 (b) APA intends to install up to six banners publicizing its anniversary, subject to
23 approval by the Department of Public Works (“Public Works”). APA seeks to install the
24 banners along the street at and around 1652 Sunnysdale Avenue, the location of the
25 Sunnysdale Community Center, where APA runs a weekly food pantry in partnership with the

1 SF-Marin Food Bank. The Community Center is also located near APA's family resource
2 center at 1704 Sunnydale Avenue.

3 Section 2. Authorization to Install Banners; Fee Waiver.

4 (a) Notwithstanding Public Works Code Section 184.78(c)'s limitation on the types of
5 banners that may be posted on City-owned utility poles, and Section 184.78(h)'s prohibition
6 on posting of banners in Residential zoning districts, Public Works shall authorize APA to post
7 up to six banners on City-owned utility poles on Sunnydale Avenue roughly fronting 1652
8 Sunnydale Avenue between August 1, 2017 and January 31, 2018, to commemorate APA's
9 30th anniversary.

10 (b) The fees set forth in Public Works Code Section 184.78 shall be waived for APA for
11 up to six banners posted on City-owned utility poles at the locations and during the time
12 period specified above.

13 (c) All other provisions of Public Works Code Section 184.78 shall apply to APA's
14 application and banners.

15
16 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
17 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
18 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
19 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
