1 [ Retroactively Accept-Expend State Grant ]

2 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL (MCJC) TO  
3 RETROACTIVELY ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$754,886  
4 FROM THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING (OCJP) FOR THE ANTI-DRUG  
5 ABUSE ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM.

6 WHEREAS, OCJP has awarded the MCJC of the City and County of San Francisco  
7 \$754,886, under the Anti-Drug Abuse Enforcement Program, to implement a coordinated local  
8 effort aimed at the apprehension, prosecution, adjudication, supervision, and treatment of drug  
9 offenders in the City and County of San Francisco; and,

10 WHEREAS, on August 28, 1998, the City and County of San Francisco authorized  
11 (Resolution No. 675-98) the MCJC, the Police Department, the Sheriff, the District Attorney, the  
12 Public Defender, and the Adult and Juvenile Probation Departments to develop this  
13 comprehensive plan for drug abatement; and,

14 WHEREAS, the entire award by the OCJP funds direct services, it is requested that  
15 indirect costs be waived; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes the MCJC to  
18 retroactively accept and expend \$754,886 from the OCJP, State of California, to support the  
19 Anti-Drug Abuse Enforcement Program; and be it further

20 RESOLVED, that the Director of the Mayor's Criminal Justice Council (MCJC) of the  
21 City and County of San Francisco is authorized to sign and approve, on the behalf of the Board  
22 of Supervisors, the Grant Award Agreement including any extensions or amendments thereof;  
23 and, be it further

24 RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant  
25 expenditures controlled by this body; and,

SUPERVISORS TENG, BECERRIL, BIERMAN, BROWN

1 IT IS AGREED, that there are no matching funds required for the project under the rules  
and regulations of OCJP; and,

2 IT IS ALSO AGREED, that any liability arising out of the performance of this Grant  
3 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the  
4 grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and OCJP disclaim any  
5 responsibility for any such action.

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


