WHEREAS, Confucian philosophy reminds people today that it is through the profession of teaching that all our communities can learn their own cultures and values and in turn are able to learn of other people's cultures and values; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco proclaims the birthday of one of the world's greatest educators, Confucius, on September 28, 2001, to be "Confucius Day;" in the City and County of San Francisco; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board recognizes and commends teachers and educators for their dedication and commitment to their students, in honor of the great philosopher Confucius.
