14 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

16 Section 1. Environmental Findings.

17 The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this  
18 ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources  
19 Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
20 Supervisors in File No. 260038 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms  
21 this determination.

23 Section 2. Chapter 94B of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising  
24 Section 94B.4, to read as follows. Section 94B.2 is reprinted in part, for informational  
25 purposes only.

1     **SEC. 94B.2. ENTERTAINMENT ZONE CONTROLS.**

2             \* \* \* \*

3             (c) All open alcoholic beverages consumed during an Entertainment Zone Event shall  
4 be purchased only from a premises located within the Entertainment Zone that is authorized  
5 under California Business and Professions Code Section 23357, 23358, or 23396, as may be  
6 amended from time to time, to permit consumers to leave the premises with open containers  
7 of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises, or an organization that is authorized  
8 by an ABC special event permit or license to make such sales within the Entertainment Zone.

10    **SEC. 94B.4. ENTERTAINMENT ZONE LOCATIONS.**

12            (b) **Additional Entertainment Zones.**

14                    **(14) Glen Park Entertainment Zone.**

15                    (A) All public streets, public rights-of-way, and sidewalks abutting both sides of  
16 Diamond Street between Monterey Boulevard and Chenery Street, Chenery Street between Brompton  
17 Avenue and Carrie Street, Monterey Boulevard between Diamond Street and Joost Avenue, and Kern  
18 Street between Brompton Avenue and Diamond Street, and all premises specified in Section 94B.2(c)  
19 that are adjacent thereto, are hereby designated as the Glen Park Entertainment Zone under Sections  
20 23039.5 and 25690 of the California Business and Professions Code.

21                    (B) Notwithstanding subsection (c), if an Entertainment Zone Event within the  
22 Glen Park Entertainment Zone does not involve the closure of a public street, it need not receive a  
23 permit for the use of a public street under Transportation Code Division I, Section 6.6 or 6.16 or  
24 Transportation Code Division II, Section 206, or other applicable authority of the SFMTA.

25            (c) Except as otherwise specified in this Section 94B.4, an Entertainment Zone Event

1 must take place in conjunction with a permit for the use of a public street under Transportation  
2 Code Division I, Section 6.6 or 6.16 or Transportation Code Division II, Section 206, or other  
3 applicable authority of the SFMTA.

6 Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors  
7 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,  
8 numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal  
9 Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment  
10 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under  
11 the official title of the ordinance.

12  
13 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective at 12:00 a.m. on the  
14 31st day after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor  
15 returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it,  
16 or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

**LEGISLATIVE DIGEST**

[Administrative Code - Glen Park Entertainment Zone]

**Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to create the Glen Park Entertainment Zone, on Diamond Street between Monterey Boulevard and Chenery Street, Chenery Street between Brompton Avenue and Carrie Street, Monterey Boulevard between Diamond Street and Joost Avenue, and Kern Steet between Brompton Avenue and Diamond Street; and affirming the Planning Department’s determination under the California Environmental Quality Act.**

Existing Law

Under Administrative Code Chapter 94B, open alcoholic beverages can be consumed on any public street, avenue, sidewalk, stairway, alley, or thoroughfare within an Entertainment Zone during an Entertainment Zone Event, subject to state and local law, when those beverages are purchased from a licensed premises within the Entertainment Zone.

Administrative Code Section 94B.1 defines an Entertainment Zone Event as “a special event permitted or licensed by ABC that occurs within the boundaries of an Entertainment Zone established in accordance with this Chapter 94B and within the hours permitted by this Chapter 94B and the Management Plan or the Downtown Activation Permit issued pursuant to Administrative Code Chapter 94D for the Entertainment Zone.” Administrative Code Section 94B.4 establishes Entertainment Zone locations.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would amend Administrative Code Section 94B.4 to create the Glen Park Entertainment Zone, on Diamond Street between Monterey Boulevard and Chenery Street, Chenery Street between Brompton Avenue and Carrie Street, Monterey Boulevard between Diamond Street and Joost Avenue, and Kern Steet between Brompton Avenue and Diamond Street.
