AUTHORIZING THE PORT OF SAN FRANCISCO TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,023,000 AND RETROACTIVELY ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$198,000 FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE PIER 52/54 PUBLIC BOAT LAUNCH AND PARKING LOT.

WHEREAS, The State of California Department of Boating and Waterways ("Cal Boating") is authorized to provide grants to cities, counties, districts and other public agencies for the construction and development of small craft launching facilities; and,

WHEREAS, On June 22, 1992 the Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 512-92, authorizing the Department of Recreation and Parks to apply for a grant from the California Department of Boating and Waterways for the purpose of renovating the public use boat launching facility at Pier 52/54; and,

WHEREAS, The Port Commission accepted the transfer of a Cal Boating grant from the San Francisco Recreation and Parks Department to fund \$295,000 of improvements at Pier 52/54 under Port Commission Resolution No. 95-7; and,

WHEREAS, On May 28, 1998, Cal Boating approved a second grant in the amount of \$198,000 to construct an off-site parking lot for more than 40 boat trailers; and,

WHEREAS, The Port of San Francisco applied for additional funding in the amount of \$1,023,000 from Cal Boating to meet rising construction costs as a result of the Mission Bay Development; and,

WHEREAS, On February 17, 1998, the San Francisco Planning Commission ruled that the Final Negative Declaration adopted and issued on September 12, 1995 remained valid and that no further environmental review was needed; and

WHEREAS, Cal Boating grants do not allow for the reimbursement of indirect costs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes the Executive Director of the Port to accept and expend a \$1,023,000 grant and to retroactively accept and expend another grant in the amount of \$198,000 from the California State Department of Boating and Waterways for the Pier 52/54 public boat launch and parking lot, and to execute all necessary documents related to this request; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget.
