

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Sudden Oak Death - \$569]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health to retroactively accept and**
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$569 from the California Department of Food and**
5 **Agriculture to fund the program entitled "Sudden Oak Death" for the period of July 1,**
6 **2011, through June 30, 2012.**

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8 WHEREAS, The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) awarded DPH
9 funding for the Sudden Oak Death Project in the amount of \$569, for the period of July 1,
10 2011 through June 30, 2012; and,

11 WHEREAS, The purpose of this project will allow DPH to contain the spread of Sudden
12 Oak Death; and,

13 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDFA requires the City to
14 enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
15 Board of Supervisors in File No.111195; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
16 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

17 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
18 for four existing positions, one Agricultural Inspector (Job Class #3450) at .002 FTE, one
19 Agricultural Inspector (Job Class #3450) at .002 FTE, one Manager I (Job Class #0922) at
20 .0005 FTE, and one Public Service Trainee (Job Class #9910) at .001 FTE, for the period of
21 July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; and,

22 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not
23 receive notification of the agreement until August 4, 2011 for a project start date of July 1,
24 2011; and,

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1 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
2 \$113; and, now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant retroactively
4 in the amount of \$569 from the CDFA; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
6 grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
8 agreement on behalf of the City.
