4 **Grove Street in recognition of San Francisco Symphony Music Director Laureate**
5 **Michael Tilson Thomas's tremendous impact on San Francisco and local arts and**
6 **culture in the City throughout his 25 years as the Symphony's Music Director, and in**
7 **celebration of his 79th birthday, in accordance with Public Works Code, Section 789 et**
8 **seq.**

10 WHEREAS, Michael Tilson Thomas made his San Francisco Symphony debut in 1974
11 at age 29 and quickly became a frequent and favorite guest conductor with the orchestra until
12 he was appointed Music Director in 1995; and

13 WHEREAS, Michael Tilson Thomas served as Music Director of the San Francisco
14 Symphony for 25 years and has made a tremendous impact on the organization and the
15 entire classical music world as a conductor, composer, pianist, educator, mentor, and
16 visionary; and

17 WHEREAS, Through his dedication to the music of pioneering American mavericks
18 such as John Adams, Henry Brant, Aaron Copland, Ruth Crawford Seeger, Morton Feldman,
19 Lou Harrison, Charles Ives, and more, Michael Tilson Thomas has helped shape the
20 American sound through San Francisco Symphony festivals, tours, and media projects; and

21 WHEREAS, Michael Tilson Thomas has contributed his own unique voice to classical
22 music through his acclaimed genre-crossing compositions, including "From the Diary of Anne
23 Frank," "Four Preludes on Playthings of the Wind," "Poems of Emily Dickinson," "Agnegram,"
24 "Urban Legend," and "Meditations on Rilke," among others; and

1 WHEREAS, Michael Tilson Thomas pushed the boundaries of traditional orchestral
2 performances during his tenure as San Francisco Symphony Music Director through cutting-
3 edge stagings of musical theater, operas, theatrical works, reinventions of symphonic
4 repertory, and the creation of the San Francisco Symphony’s acclaimed SoundBox series in
5 2014; and

6 WHEREAS, Michael Tilson Thomas’s deep commitment to education and mentorship
7 has affected the lives of countless young people through the expansion of the San Francisco
8 Symphony’s education initiatives during his tenure, his co-founding of the New World
9 Symphony in Miami in 1987, and his personal mentorship of a new generation of classical
10 musicians, including conductor and composer Teddy Abrams, composer Mason Bates, pianist
11 Yuja Wang, and mezzo-soprano Sasha Cooke; and

12 WHEREAS, Michael Tilson Thomas created the acclaimed multimedia education series
13 “Keeping Score” in 2004, making classical music more accessible to people of all ages and
14 musical backgrounds; and

15 WHEREAS, Michael Tilson Thomas and the San Francisco Symphony’s recordings—
16 many of them released through the Symphony’s own SFS Media label, which launched under
17 MTT’s leadership—have been recognized with 12 Grammy Awards; and

18 WHEREAS, Michael Tilson Thomas is an Officier de l’Ordre des Arts et des Lettres of
19 France, a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, a member of the
20 American Academy of Arts and Letters, a National Medal of Arts recipient, a Peabody Award
21 winner, a Kennedy Center Honoree, and a member of the California Hall of Fame; and

22 WHEREAS, Michael Tilson Thomas is a vital part of the cultural makeup of San
23 Francisco, championing the city through national and international orchestral tours, and
24 collaborating frequently with Bay Area luminaries, composers, and bands; and

1 WHEREAS, Michael Tilson Thomas has made an indelible mark on San Francisco and
2 on the San Francisco Symphony; and

3 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Public Works Code, Sections 789 et seq., Mayor London N.
4 Breed is requesting the designation of commemorative street signage in honor of the
5 contributions and accomplishments of Michael Tilson Thomas; and

6 WHEREAS, The designation of street signage is commemorative in nature and is not
7 subject to procedural hearings or noticing pursuant to California Streets and Highway Code,
8 Sections 970.5 and 5026; California Government Code, Section 5026; and San Francisco
9 Transportation Code, Section 2.2 for official street names; now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That in order to celebrate the legacy of Michael Tilson Thomas on the
11 occasion of his 79th birthday, there shall be an honorary naming of the 200 block of Grove
12 Street, between Franklin Street and Van Ness Avenue, as "MTT Way" in recognition of
13 Michael Tilson Thomas's invaluable contributions to the City and County of San Francisco;
14 and, be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests that the Municipal
16 Transportation Agency erect commemorative street signage on the 200 block of Grove Street,
17 between Franklin Street and Van Ness Avenue, indicating both the honorary street name and
18 the existing official street name, either on a single sign distinguishing the honorary street
19 name from the official street name or on separate signs, with the honorary name "MTT Way"
20 placed beneath the existing official street name; and, be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Works is directed to add the
22 honorary street name to its official list of Commemorative Street Names in accordance with
23 the Public Works Code, Section 789 et seq.




