

1 [Residential Permit Parking Exemption – Itinerant Teachers]

3 **Ordinance authorizing the Department of Parking and Traffic to issue city-wide permits**  
4 **to exempt San Francisco Unified School District itinerant teachers and designated**  
5 **school administrators from Residential Permit Parking regulations.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Article 15 of the San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by amending  
11 Section 308.3, to read as follows:

12 **SEC. 308.3. EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION PERMITS.**

13 (a) Upon written request, the Director of Parking and Traffic shall issue to the principal or  
14 chief administrator of an educational institution located within a residential permit parking area  
15 transferable daytime parking permits for the use of persons employed as teachers at such  
16 institution who operate commuter vehicles, which permits would be valid for parking between  
17 the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

18 (b) The Director of Parking and Traffic is authorized to issue *a maximum of ten* ~~10~~ *and a*  
19 *minimum of three* annual parking permits per institution, or the number of parking permits that  
20 equals the number of on-street unrestricted parking spaces available between an extension of  
21 each property line of said institution to the middle of the public streets or highways upon  
22 which the institution directly abuts, as determined by survey of the Department of Public  
23 Works, whichever is the lesser number, but in no event less than three permits.

24 (c) Each parking permit issued by the Director of Parking and Traffic pursuant to this  
25 Section shall be valid for one year from the date established by the Director of Parking and

1 Traffic. Permits may be repurchased annually upon reapplication by the principal or chief  
2 administrator of the educational institution in the manner required by the Director of Parking  
3 and Traffic. In dispensing of the permits for a particular educational institution, the principal or  
4 chief administrator thereof shall give consideration to those teachers who are participating in  
5 a carpool or other method of transportation. The fee for issuance of each permit provided for  
6 in this Section shall be *consistent with the annual permit fee established in Section 314(e)*. ~~\$21~~  
7 ~~regardless of the date of purchase or repurchase.~~

8 (d) *The Director of Parking and Traffic may issue a city-wide permit to those itinerant teachers*  
9 *and designated school administrators who provide services to more than one school site and who have*  
10 *been approved by the Superintendent of the San Francisco Unified School District, or his or her*  
11 *designee. The permit shall exempt the holder from residential parking area regulations when*  
12 *performing official functions of the job and will be valid for one year upon date of issuance and subject*  
13 *to an annual fee consistent with the annual permit fee established in Section 314(e). The Director of*  
14 *Parking and Traffic shall also issue rules and regulations, not inconsistent with this Article, governing*  
15 *the manner in which approved personnel may qualify for such permits and shall provide for penalties*  
16 *for their misuse.*

17 (e) The term “educational institution” shall mean any school or other place of learning  
18 providing a pre-school, elementary or secondary level of study, and which regularly employs a  
19 staff of at least 15 certificated employees or persons regularly employed as classroom  
20 teachers.
