Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Emergency Medical Services (SFDPH, EMS) to accept and expend retroactively funds in the amount of \$920,650 from the Emergency Medical Services Fund (EMSF) to reimburse providers for emergency medical services rendered during the period of July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2004, and for administrative costs associated with this program.

WHEREAS, Revenues are collected from moving violations through the San Francisco traffic courts and deposited into the EMSF; and,

WHEREAS, SFDPH, EMS receives funding under the EMSF to reimburse physicians for uncompensated care provided in emergency departments; and,

WHEREAS, A one-time surplus of funds in the amount of \$920,650 is now available for such reimbursement for services provided during FY 2002-2003 and FY 2003-2004; and,

WHEREAS, Funds in the amount of \$850,746 will be allocated from this one-time surplus to reimburse physicians for emergency services, and funds in the amount of \$69,904 will be allocated to contract with a fiscal intermediary to do claims processing, for a total of \$920,650; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 277-92 established the current framework for the EMSF, is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 97-92-42, and is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and.

WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of these funds for reimbursement of physicians and claims processing by not including indirect costs in the funds budget; and.

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WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors because the one-time surplus of these funds was not identified until March, 2003 and the EMSF has already depleted its funding for emergency physician services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That SFDPH, EMS is hereby authorized to accept and expend a one-time surplus of funds in the amount of \$920,650 from EMSF; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH, EMS is hereby authorized to accept and expend the funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in Ordinance No. 277-92; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement in behalf of the City.
