1	[Reconsideration of Board of Supervisors Raise.]

3	Resolution requesting that the Civil Service Commission reconsider its decision to give
4	the Board of Supervisors a \$74,735 raise.
5	
6	WHEREAS, on November 5, 2002 the voters approved Proposition J; and,
7	WHEREAS, Proposition J authorized the Civil Service Commission to set the salaries
8	for the Board of Supervisors; and,
9	WHEREAS, on May 19, 2003 the Civil Service Commission voted to give the Board of
10	Supervisors a \$74,735 raise to \$112,320; and,
11	WHEREAS, the City is not giving a raise to City employees due to the projected \$347
12	million shortfall; and,
13	WHEREAS, the City has requested City employees to give back \$90 million by
14	contributing 7.5% to their employee retirement contribution; and,
15	WHEREAS, departmental budgets are being reduced, programs cut and employees
16	laid off to balance the budget; and,
17	WHEREAS, this proposed raise would mean further reductions in programs or further
18	layoffs; and,
19	WHEREAS, Proposition J allows the Civil Service Commission to change its
20	determination; now, therefore, be it
21	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors request the Civil Service Commission to
22	change its decision to give the Board of Supervisors a \$74,735 raise per member.
