17 WHEREAS, The Controller has certified that the funds are available for  
18 settlement in the amount of \$1,452.00; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Controller be and is hereby authorized and directed to  
20 draw a warrant for Kathryn Hall and for the amount of \$1,452.00 for reimbursement for  
21 the cost of personal property of a City and County employee damaged or stolen in the  
22 line of duty and without fault on the part of the employee.


