3 **Ordinance authorizing the Office of the Treasurer-Tax Collector to accept and expend a**
4 **grant in the amount of up to \$80,000 from the Earned Assets Resource Network for**
5 **implementing the Office of Financial Empowerment Kindergarten to College program,**
6 **and amending Ordinance 165-12 (Annual Salary Ordinance, FYs 2012-2013 and 2013-**
7 **2014) to provide for the creation of one (1) grant-funded position in the Office of**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Findings.

11 (a) The Office of Financial Empowerment in the Office of the Treasurer-Tax
12 Collector was awarded an up to \$80,000 grant from the Earned Assets Resource Network on
13 August 7, 2012. The purpose of the grant is to hire and provide funding for a staff position to
14 conduct outreach to families in the Kindergarten to College program.

15 (b) The City and County of San Francisco established the Kindergarten to College
16 program in 2010 to provide college savings accounts for San Francisco Unified School District
17 kindergarteners with an initial deposit of \$50, provide financial education curriculum, and
18 encourage savings for higher education.

19 Section 2. Authorization to accept and expend grant funds.

20 (a) The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the Treasurer-Tax
21 Collector to accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, funds
22 from the Earned Assets Resource Network in the amount of \$80,000 for the purpose of
23 implementing the Office of Financial Empowerment Kindergarten to College program.

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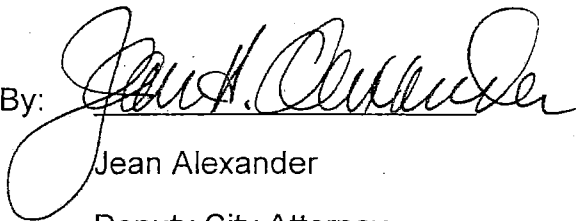

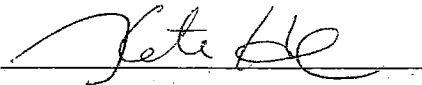

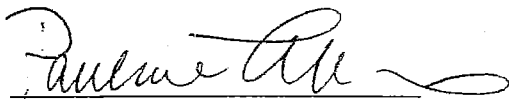

Proposed Grant Project Summary: Kindergarten to College (K2C) is a college savings program for San Francisco Unified School District kindergarten students with an initial \$50 deposit from the City and County of San Francisco. In the 2012-13 school year K2C will expand to all San Francisco kindergartens after a two year phase-in period at one quarter, then one half of kindergartens. EARN has granted up to \$80,000 for one outreach position to work with schools and families on this program. K2C has budgeted \$80,000 for the position.

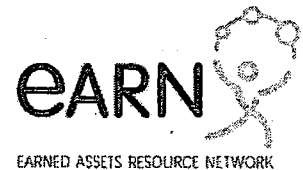

We are pleased to inform you that the Earned Assets Resource Network (EARN) has authorized a grant of up to \$80,000 for the San Francisco Office of Financial Empowerment (OFE), housed within the Office of the Treasurer and Tax Collector. This grant will be paid in two installments in January 2013 and July 2013 or until the funds are expended.

The Office of Financial Empowerment will use these funds to create a full-time position to expand outreach in support of the Kindergarten to College (K2C) program. This position will coordinate outreach activities for K2C and provide professional development training and materials to deliver financial education in the classroom for nearly 350 kindergarten, 1st grade and 2nd grade teachers, impacting nearly 8,000 students. If the OFE would like to use these funds for any other purpose, it must obtain written approval from EARN.

The OFE agrees to provide EARN with an annual report on July 1st 2013, detailing the use of the grant funds until the grant funds have been fully expended. Each report shall include a financial accounting as to the use and disposition of the grant funds, signed by a financial officer of your organization; and accomplishments and specific outcomes for clients achieved under the grant.
